UNIT – I

READING

UNIT – II

WRITING

<u>UNIT – III</u>

SPEAKING

Exposure to a variety of speaking activities, general convocation, communication through telephones, public address system etc., official conversations, speaking in group discussions, interviews etc., and public speaking speech training in the areas of faculty pronunciation, mannerisms and intonation patterns, phonetics to the extent of enabling the student to use the dictionary for the purpose of correct pronunciation for a variety of purposes.

UNIT-1V

LISTENING

Exposure to listening for improving listening comprehension – listening to lectures, listening to conversation, listening in group discussions, interviews etc., listening comprehension tests in exams like TOEFL etc., Note making given emphasis.

UNIT-V

GRAMMAR

Grammar in terms related to units A, B,C,D – transformations of sentences, direct, indirect, active and passive, error analysis, phonetics, vocabulary problems, articles, prepositions and verbs.
